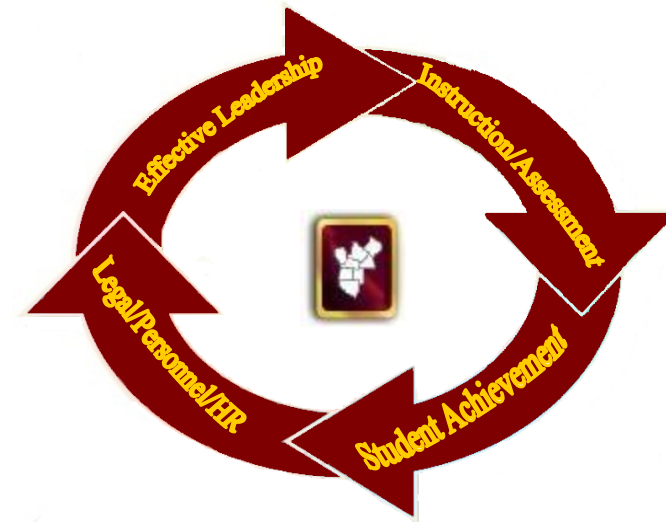


Lodging
