A productive Individualized Education Program (IEP) meeting requires that the IEP team — teachers, families, and related services providers — have the resources they need to collaborate to create measurable, legally defensible, and truly individualized IEPs for each student. This fully online class explores some of the most crucial aspects of creating and implementing effective IEPs that increase student achievement.

The class is organized into 3 modules, Role of LEA; Transition Planning; Progress Monitoring, that will be completed over a two-week period. The class is designed as a complement to the IEP Bootcamp professional learning class or for staff that are exploring how to move beyond compliance when creating and implementing IEPs.
