## Teaching of Reading and Writing (K-12) HYBRID Schedule New format for this class!

This course is being offered in a **Hybrid** format. The class will meet face to face three times during the course and the **remainder of the work will be completed online.**

This course is an introduction to literacy development for students, grades kindergarten through high school. The course will investigate current research best practices in reading/writing education. The nature of the struggling reader will be explored. Other topics include the Georgia Performance Standards for ELA, use of reading and writing across the curriculum, and the five domains of reading as defined by the National Reading Panel (2001).
