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## <u>Responsibilities and Information</u> for the 2023 Academic Bowl Coaches

Note: There will only be one (1) contact for each team for the 2022-2023 GRESA Academic Bowl.

- Academic Bowl Coaches' training will be at 4:30 PM on August 25, 2022, at Griffin RESA with Academic Bowl Coordinator, Christopher Harper.
- Team registration fee is \$150 per team. Coaches should complete the online registration form at <a href="https://bit.ly/3vO6Mlp">https://bit.ly/3vO6Mlp</a>. Griffin RESA will invoice each school/team.
- Coaches are asked to provide feedback and support for their team as needed throughout the school year.
- Coaches will act as the line of communication between the Griffin RESA Academic Bowl Coordinator and your organization, including students and parents, regarding all Academic Bowl concerns.

Competition format will be online and asynchronous. All teams compete simultaneously. Middle School division is 6<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grades. JV division is 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> grades. Varsity division is 9<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grades.

Up to 10 players may compete at a time. Team members can collaborate during competitions. The school coach must be present and observe each competition to ensure all rules are followed. Coaches may not assist in answering questions or entering responses.

Each competition session is a two-week window. One (1) competition session of 60 minutes is allowed for each team in the window. Each session will have 100 questions. Player substitution is only permitted immediately following the  $25^{th}$ ,  $50^{th}$ , and  $75^{th}$  questions. Devices and calculators are not allowed. No materials of any kind can be used to search for or aid the team in answering questions. Blank scratch paper is permitted.

Scoring is automatic through the Class Maker software. Each question is worth 5 points. Required mathematical units are required in answers. Teams should contact the Academic Bowl Coordinator within 24 hours of the end of the competition window for the round if they would like an answer reconsidered. Seasonal standings will be computed by cumulative points. Only the top four (4) teams will receive regional recognition. The top three (3) teams will receive a trophy.
