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



The Computer Science Endorsement is a three-course program that meets the GaPSC 505-3-86 Computer Science rule, ISTE Standards and Computer Science Teachers Association Standards. This endorsement will prepare PK-12 candidates with the foundational knowledge within computer science through exploration of computer hardware, software tools, and video game design.


