- Proposals for presentations should be submitted using the attached format, and the submission form should be faxed (770-228-7316) or emailed to Kathy Snow at ksnow@griffinresa.net or mailed to Griffin RESA (440 Tilney Avenue, Griffin, GA 30224). The submission form can also be located on the Griffin RESA website under “*Summer Leadership Conference Call for Presentations.*”
- All proposals should include at least three learning objectives that indicate exactly how the attendees will benefit from the presentation.
- No sales-pitches please. Direct promotions of products, services, or monetary self-interest are not appropriate for this conference.
- Registration and travel expenses: Presenters at the conference are also considered attendees of the event and are expected to pay their own travel expenses and the appropriate registration fee.

How Are Presentations Selected?

All submissions will be reviewed and evaluated by the Conference Planning Committee. The evaluation process will take into consideration (1) Relevance and pertinence of the presentation topic; (2) Practical application and take-away knowledge material that can be used by the attendees in their day-to-day work settings; and (3) Freshness of topic (*presentation addresses critical issues, emerging trends, and innovative methods and practices*).
