Classroom Management for 6-12 Teachers

Classroom management is not simply the absence of discipline problems, but an intentional set of practices that promote a positive environment for all students. What does this look like in the secondary face-to-face classroom? What does it look like in a virtual learning environment? Routines, rituals, protocols, and strategies intentionally taught and reinforced that promote engagement, prevent off-task behaviors, and communicate caring with all, especially struggling, students. This course is designed to help teachers in grades 6-12 organize and manage the learning environment to create a sense of community and maximize academic success. The course will provide ideas, strategies, and emotional objectivity to promote learning in face to face and virtual settings. This course supports teacher performance in Standard 7 of TKES and is suitable for both beginning and veteran teachers who wish to set their students up for success with proactive, positive classroom management supports.
