## How to Understand a Psychoeducational Evaluation

What may seem to be intimidating to some, may be one of the most powerful resources educators have access to. The psychoeducational evaluation report details a student's strengths, weaknesses, and neurological development. School psychologists and other identified professionals conduct a battery of assessments that guide the process and development of a student's evaluation report. This information is used by educators and families when making educational, academic, and functional decisions for students with disabilities. This session will provide participants with a deeper understanding of how to understand the implications of a psychoeducational evaluation and the application of this understanding when making instructional decisions in the classroom setting.
