PBIS Overview for Administrators

This presentation is a virtual 1.5-hour administrative PBIS overview. The content is intended for district staff and school administrators. The overview serves as a "refresher" for administrators who already implement the PBIS framework and serves as an overview for new administrators who may have been appointed to a school utilizing PBIS where the administrator was not involved in the initial school-wide training. Additional support is available to administrators through RESA School Climate Specialists and the Georgia Department of Education School Climate Specialists who work together to support schools and districts.

The **Positive Behavior Interventions and Support** system is an evidence-based school-wide reform effort aimed at modifying the school climate, with a shift from *reactive and punitive* methods to *proactive, educational* methods. PBIS is a data driven decision making system that improves outcomes for students and staff when implemented with fidelity. PBIS is currently being utilized in over 1200 schools in Georgia.
