For New Special Education Teachers

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA") requires school districts to monitor progress on the goals in the Individual Education Programs ("IEPs") for students with special education needs. Progress monitoring is the scientifically based practice of specifically measuring progress regarding a specific area of need. Without appropriate progress monitoring, there is no way of knowing whether a student is making progress, and whether revisions to the student's special education programming are necessary. This course will discuss writing measurable goals, selecting appropriate progress monitoring tools, and how to organize the materials in a readily accessible way.
