K-5 Science Endorsement Program

Class Descriptions and Candidate Requirements

This three-course series required by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission to earn the K-5 Science Endorsement. The series consists of three courses 1) *Teaching Science in Early Childhood*, 2) *Life and Earth Science* and 3) *Physical and Space Science*.

The program consists of a total of 50 hours of instruction. Admission to the program requires the recommendation of candidates by school and system administrators. Candidates must be approved for admission before being eligible to register for the first course. The K-5 Science Endorsement courses are conducted in a cohort format and will be offered several times each year. Candidates will be required to complete the endorsement program only in the sequence listed above.

Eligibility requirements include documentation of the following:

- o A minimum of one full year of successful teaching experience;
- o A valid Georgia teaching certificate Level 4 or higher
- o A full-time contracted position
- o Recommendations from the school principal or district leader.

Attendance Policy

A strict, non-negotiable attendance policy will be enforced for each of the three courses in the K-5 Science Endorsement program. Candidates will be expected to attend all class meetings in their entirety. No credit may be awarded to candidates who miss more than 10% of class time in any of the three courses.



Class Descriptions and Candidate Requirements

This three-course series required by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission to earn the Dyslexia Endorsement. The series consists of three courses 1) *Foundations of Language and Literacy Development and Dyslexia*, 2) *Assessment and Evidence-Based Reading Instruction for Students with Dyslexia* and 3) *Methods in Multi-Sensory Instruction and Interventions*.

The program consists of a total of 50 hours of instruction. Admission to the program requires the recommendation of candidates by school and system administrators. Candidates must be approved for admission before being eligible to register for the first course. The Dyslexia Endorsement courses are conducted in a cohort format and will be offered several times each year. Candidates will be required to complete the endorsement program only in the sequence listed above.


