As we head into fall and hopefully a little cooler weather, we have some great news to share with you.

We have two one-day conferences coming up in the near future. Our “Instructional Coaches Drive-in Conference” is on September 28th and the theme for this year is “Critical Levers in Improving Student Achievement.” This drive-in conference will have several strands including building relationships with coaches, courageous conversations, implementing the coaching cycle, roles of the coach, and using data to develop coaching plans.

We will also have our annual “Paraprofessional Conference.” It is on November 2nd this year and the theme this year is “Paraprofessional Power.” This drive-in conference will have several strands including supporting struggling learners, low profile behavior interventions, engagement strategies, and strategies for supporting the classroom teacher. Lodging, if needed, is on our website and includes local hotels and a bed and breakfast.
