Schools and systems continue to strive to develop processes for students to obtain individualized help in the regular classroom for learning or behavior difficulties. As a result, our profession needs highly competent and knowledgeable leadership and coordination at the school and system levels. This program will equip candidates with the skills, knowledge, and dispositions to lead the process, particularly as the importance of multi-tiered support has grown in the age of Response to Intervention (RTI). Educators responsible for leading RTI, MTSS, and 504 at the school or district level are urged to apply for this program. Instruction will take place completely online, followed by a job-embedded field experience to complete the program.
