This course will demonstrate how to encourage students to reason mathematically, engage in productive struggle and meaningful discourse, evaluate mathematical arguments, communicate ideas using mathematical terminology, and make connections among mathematical topics and other disciplines, according to Van de Walle and other experts on teaching math.
